





Think of all the good that has come from their lives, and follow the example of their faith. Verse 8. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. Verse 9. So do not be attracted by strange, new ideas. Your strength comes from God's grace, not from rules about food, which don't help those who follow them. NLT



Verse 10. We have an altar from which the priests in the Tabernacle have no right to eat. Verse 11. Under the old system, the high priest brought the blood of animals into the Holy Place as a sacrifice for sin, and the bodies of the animals were burned outside the camp. Verse 12. So also Jesus suffered and died outside the city gates NLT



Verse 17. Obey your spiritual leaders, and do what they say. Their work is to watch over your souls, and they are accountable to God. Give them reason to do this with joy and not with sorrow.
