



Verse 6. Yes, if she refuses to wear a head covering, she should cut off all her hair! But since it is shameful for a woman to have her hair cut or her head shaved, she should wear a covering. Verse 7. A man should not wear anything on his head when worshipping, for man is made in God's image and reflects God's glory. And woman reflects man's glory.





Well, I certainly will not praise you for this! Verse 23. For I pass on to you what I received from the Lord himself. On the night when he was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took some bread Verse 24. and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said,

"This is my body, which is given for you. Do this to remember me." Verse 25. In the same way, he took the cup of wine after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant between God and his people -- an agreement confirmed with my blood. Do this to remember me as often as you drink it."




