


are a great and awesome God! You always fulfill your covenant and keep your promises
of unfailing love to those who love you and obey your commands. Verse 5. But we have sinned and done wrong. We have rebelled against you and scorned your commands and regulations.




Verse 6. We have refused to listen to your servants the prophets, who spoke on your authority to our kings and princes and ancestors and to all the people of the land. Verse 7. "Lord, you are in the right; but as you see, our faces are covered with shame. This is true of all of us, including the people of Judah and Jerusalem and all Israel, NLT




Verse 9. But the Lord our God is merciful and forgiving, even though we have rebelled




Verse 11. All Israel has disobeyed your instruction and turned away, refusing to listen to your voice. "So now the solemn curses and judgments written in the Law of Moses, the servant of God, have been poured down on us because of our sin.




Verse 12. You have kept your word and done to us and our rulers exactly as you warned. Never has there been such a disaster as happened in Jerusalem. Verse 13. Every curse written against us in the Law of Moses has come true. Yet we have refused to seek mercy from the LORD our God NLT




by turning from our sins and recognizing his truth. Verse 14. Therefore, the LORD has
brought upon us the disaster he prepared. The LORD our God was right to do all of these things, for we did not obey him. Verse 15. "O Lord our God, you brought lasting NLT




honor to your name by rescuing your people from Egypt in a great display of power. But we have sinned and are full of wickedness. Verse 16. In view of all your faithful mercies, Lord, please turn your furious anger away from your city Jerusalem, your holy mountain. NLT



All the neighboring nations mock Jerusalem and your people because of our sins and
the sins of our ancestors. Verse 17. "O our God, hear your servant's prayer! Listen as I plead. For your own sake, Lord, smile again on your desolate sanctuary.




Verse 18. "O my God, lean down and listen to me. Open your eyes and see our despair.See how your city -- the city that bears your name -- lies in ruins. We make this plea, notbecause we deserve help, but because of your mercy.NLT




Verse 19. "O Lord, hear. O Lord, forgive. O Lord, listen and act! For your own sake, do not delay, O my God, for your people and your city bear your name." Verse 20. I went on praying and confessing my sin and the sin of my people, NLT







Verse 24. "A period of seventy sets of seven has been decreed for your people and your holy city to finish their rebellion, to put an end to their sin, to atone for their guilt, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to confirm the prophetic vision, and to anoint the Most Holy Place. Verse 25. Now listen and understand! Seven sets of seven plus sixty-two sets NLT




of seven will pass from the time the command is given to rebuild Jerusalem until a ruler
-- the Anointed One -- comes. Jerusalem will be rebuilt with streets and strong defenses, despite the perilous times. Verse 26. "After this period of sixty-two sets of seven, the Anointed One will



be killed, appearing to have accomplished nothing, and a ruler will arise whose armies will destroy the city and the Temple. The end will come with a flood, and war and its miseries are decreed from that time to the very end. NLT





Verse 27. The ruler will make a treaty with the people for a period of one set of seven, but after half this time, he will put an end to the sacrifices and offerings. And as a climax to all his terrible deeds, he will set up a sacrilegious object that causes desecration, until the fate decreed for this defiler is finally poured out on him." NLT
