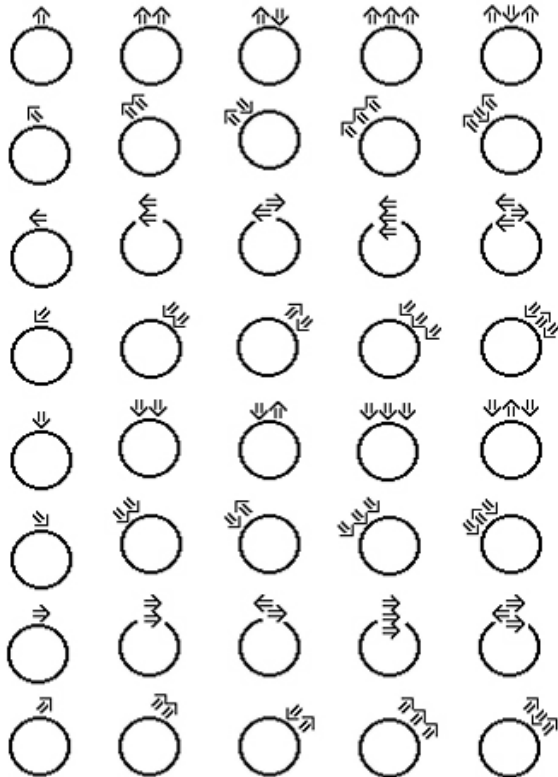


Head Movement is written with arrows above the Head Circle, and your nose follows the direction of the arrows. It is a movement, like looking up, looking diagonal, looking side to side - and you can feel your neck stretch and move. Your nose us following the direction of the arrow.

Head Movement

Face-Direction Movement Symbols

The nose moves in the direction of the arrows.
The neck bends and stretches as the nose moves.



But non-moving Head Positions (see below), sometimes called the Face Direction Line, is a static position of the Head, and there is no Movement - only a placement of the Nose Looking-Up or the Nose Looking-Down, and just the position without movement - these symbols are used a lot when there are Shoulder Lines written and you need to show the neck in an exact position relating to the Shoulder Line

This is not movement. It is a stable position marking the direction of the nose and face, relating to the shoulders.
