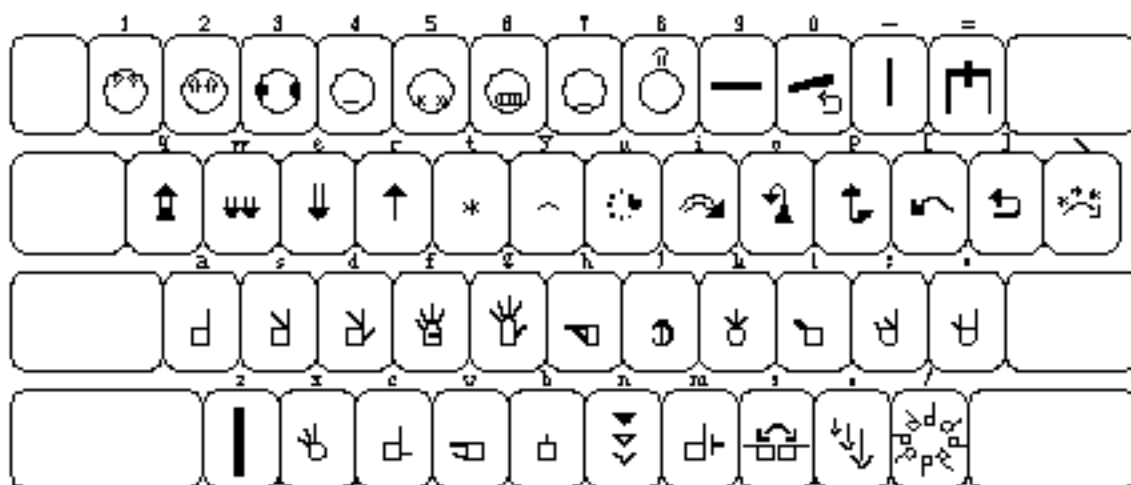

Now Sign Language users have a way to type in their own language. Handshapes, movement symbols and facial expressions rotate and flop with simple keystrokes. And since SignWriter includes a built-in Sign Language dictionary, many signs are pre-typed for you, and can be pasted into documents while you type.

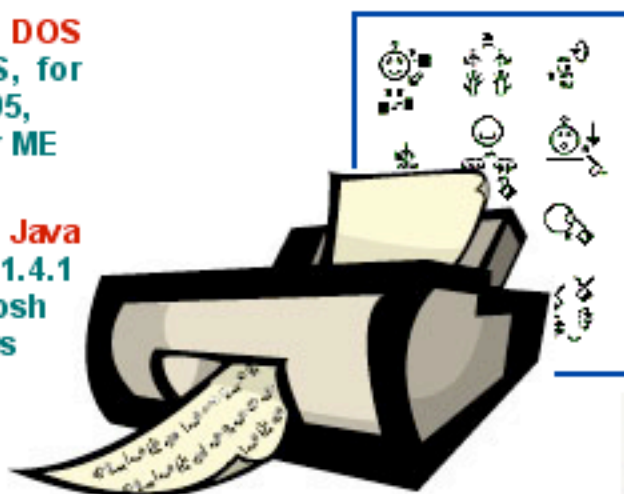


10 Spoken Languages, 17 Signed Languages
