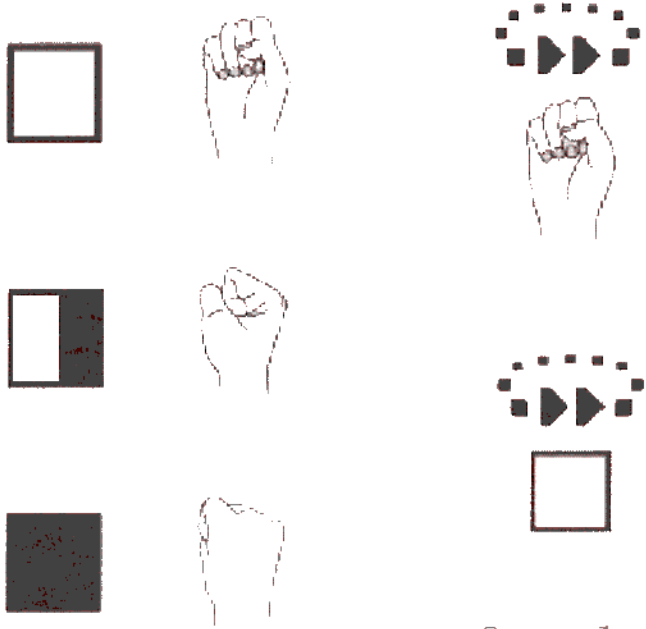
Learn how to read ASL in SignWriting

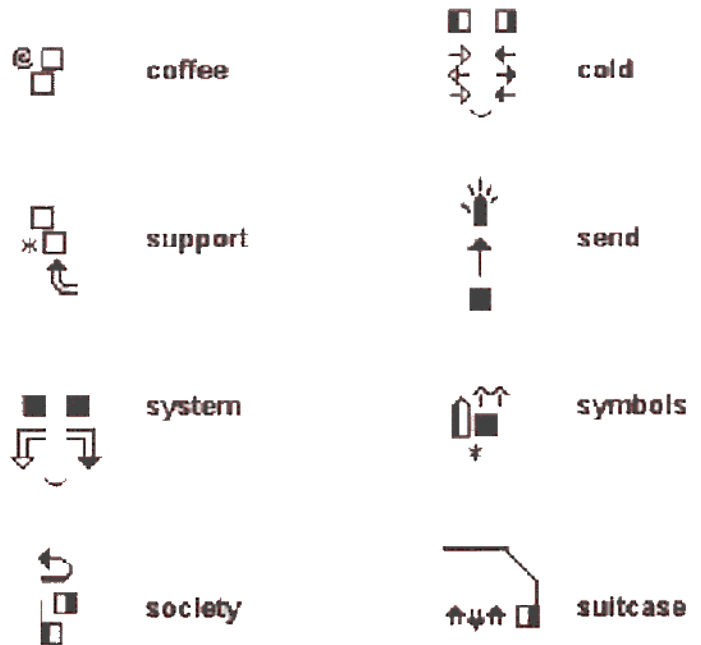
SignWriting is a way to read and write American Sign Language (ASL) or any Sign Language in the world. Let's learn how to read ASL together!

Tight Fist

A square is a Tight Fist. The direction in which the palm is facing is indicated by dark or light tones. A dark square shows the back of the hand, while a light square shows the palm of the hand. If the square is half dark and half white, that shows the side of the hand.
