





Sign Languages are not international. There is a different Sign Language in every country. Some countries have several Sign Languages. Sign Languages are beautiful naturally-evolved languages used by generations of Deaf families. Children born of Deaf parents, who use Sign Language as their first language at home, are called native signers. Native signers have normal language development, because Sign Languages are sophisticated languages with rich grammar structures.

SignWriting is an alphabet that writes the handshapes, movements and facial expressions of any signed language. Sign Languages are now becoming written languages because of SignWriting. It is used to write more than 40 Sign Languages around the world.


