HOW TO WRITE INTERLOCKING FINGERS when using the International SignWriting Alphabet 2008


- 1. Find the sign in SignPuddle.
- 2. Click on the Write Sign Button to edit the sign.



3. This loads the sign back into the SignBox for editing.


4. Find the Simultaneous Line (also called the Same-Time Line) under the Dynamics section of the ISWA.

Drag the curved line into the SignBox...



5. Place the curved line on top of the hands, making the fingers look interlocked.

6. Press the Place Over Button to be sure the tiny curved line is really "on top" of the hands.



7. Press the "Add to SignPuddle" button to save the sign.
