



6. Standing nearby were six stone water jars, used for Jewish ceremonial washing. Each could hold twenty to thirty gallons. 7. Jesus told the servants, "Fill the jars with water." When the jars had been filled,

8. he said, "Now dip some out, and take it to the master of ceremonies." So the servants followed his instructions. 9. When the master of ceremonies tasted the water that was now wine, not knowing where it had come from (though, of course, the servants knew), he called the bridegroom over.




10. "A host always serves the best wine first," he said. "Then, when everyone has had a lot to drink, he brings out the less expensive wine. But you have kept the best until now!"

11. This miraculous sign at Cana in Galilee







14. In the Temple area he saw merchants selling cattle, sheep, and doves for sacrifices; he also saw dealers at tables exchanging foreign money. 15. Jesus made a whip from some ropes



and chased them all out of the Temple. He drove out the sheep and cattle, scattered the money changers' coins over the floor, and turned over their tables. 16. Then, going over to the people who sold doves, he told them, "Get these things out of here. NLT


